



# SSCB Child Exploitation Training

## Course Outline

To ensure that it is recognised that many young people (both boys & girls) are vulnerable or involved in sexual exploitation, (including exchanging sex, abusive images, grooming & through new technology), and that workers can make a difference by understanding & recognising the issue, implementing local procedures, working together and responding appropriately.

## Objectives

By the end of the training participants will be able to:

- Understand that all sexual exploitation is child abuse.
- Define the issue to include all forms of sexual exploitation which will include FGM, forced marriage.
- Understand the sexual offences legislation and how this protects children.
- Recognise when young people may be at risk or involved by identifying vulnerability & warning signs.
- Know when to share information and explore issues around confidentiality versus protection with particular reference to Ian Huntley.
- Confirm the importance of young peoples participation in decisions affecting their own safety and the level of abuse involved in sexual exploitation.
- Explain sexual exploitation and Staffordshire SSCB's sexually active young people policies and Inter-agency Safeguarding procedures.
- Be familiar with sexually active young people policies and to recognise abusive, coercive relationships.
- Review government guidance and understand local responses.
- Recognise vulnerability and warning signs.
- Understand the lessons learnt from national & local Serious Case Reviews (where appropriate).
- Understand the importance of speaking / listening to children alone to enable practitioners to have a greater understanding of that 'child's world'
