Course Outline

To highlight the vulnerability to abuse of children with disabilities.

Objectives

By the end of the training participants will be able to:

- Reflect on factors that create vulnerability for the abuse of disabled children.
- Understand what causes confusion about signs and indicators of abuse.
- Have an awareness of the parental perspective and the potential impact on the worker.
- Understand how to challenge the professional opinion of others.
- Understand the importance of understanding the 'child's world' and communicating with children about their views.
- Understand the current situation in relation to research on prevalence of abuse of disabled children.
- Understand the vulnerability of disabled children and the confusion around child abuse and disability.
- Understand the role of communication.
- Have Increased confidence in practice, particularly in relation to the assessment framework.
- Understand local SSCB policy and procedures.
- Understand when a CAF assessment might be appropriate.
- Understand the lessons learnt from local / national / Serious Case Reviews (where appropriate)
